### LOCAL RULES

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- a) Beyond any fence or beyond any hedge bounding the course.
   In or beyond the demarcation line between the 17th and the practice ground and the extension of that line if on the path.
- b) Over the edge of the cliffs.
- c) Over the fence bounding the railway line.
- d) Playing the 5th the ball is out of bounds when, past the first white stake, it is over the hedge on the left, going to the 5th green.
- e) Over the hedge on either side of the lane when playing the 6th.
- f) Within the bounds marked by white stakes around the greenkeepers' shed and surrounding area.
- g) Playing the 9th you are out of bounds if your ball is left of the white stakes/line between the 8th & 9th fairways - the out of bounds extends from the first to the last white marker stakes. PENALTY - Stroke and distance Rule 18.2a(2). The quarry in front of the 9th green is a yellow penalty area - Relief as Rule 17.1d.

### 2. MINE SHAFTS

All mine shafts within the boundaries of the course are integral parts of the course and not obstructions. There is therefore no relief.

3. TRACTOR AND WHEEL MARKS A ball coming to rest in any deep rutted tractor or wheel mark, anywhere on the course, may be lifted and dropped within one club-length but not nearer the hole, without penalty.

### 4. BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are loose impediments. Relief is available under Rule 15.1. If the ball moves as a result of moving the stone, the player gets a one stroke penalty and the ball must be replaced.

# 5. RULE 16.1 OBSTRUCTIONS All the artificial surfaces on all

All the artificial surfaces on all the paths and roads within the boundaries of the course. NOT the naturally worn paths on the cliff edges. Fixed sprinkler heads, manhole covers or junction boxes are immovable obstructions.

### 6. TEMPORARY GREENS

At all times when temporary greens are in play a player may tap down any uneven surface on the line of the putt without penalty.

### 7. GROUND UNDER REPAIR


Grass cuttings and other material left on the course which have been abandoned are not intended to be removed and are not ground under repair. If a ball comes to rest in an area marked Ground Under Repair (white painted areas) the ball MUST be lifted as in Rule 16.1a. Exception - if a dropping zone is clearly marked the ball MUST be dropped in the zone.

### 8. PRESERVATION AREAS

All temporary greens, the green 14a (adjoining the 15th fairway) except when 14a replaces a hole out of play, are declared to be areas requiring preservation.

A ball coming to rest in such areas MUST be lifted and dropped within one club-length at a point affording nearest point of relief and not nearer the hole, without penalty.

## COURSE MAP


